

Food Resources in Dawes County

Some distribution options have been updated to accommodate the Coronavirus safety recommendations. Delivery may be available for those in need. Please ask if needed.

Bread Basket- Provides weekly food distributions, mostly dairy & bread products St. Patrick's Catholic Assumption Arena, East Side-300 block of Spruce St., Chadron (308)-432-2626 Tuesdays, 10 AM till food is gone; no eligibility requirements. [The building is closed to the public, but volunteers will be distributing food outside.](#)

Closer to Home- Lunch, no charge. Open to all. 365 Main St., Masonic Hall, Chadron, weekdays from 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM; open to all. [The building is closed to the public, but volunteers will be distributing food outside. Please pull up on 4th Street, facing east \(toward Main Street\), stay in your car and volunteers will bring take-out food out.](#)

Crawford Food Pantry- Groceries to supplement normal supplies 11 Paddock St., Crawford-Backdoor at the Health Clinic Mondays 5-6:45 PM; Wednesdays 10 AM-11:45 AM; limited to 3 times monthly. [The building is closed to the public, but volunteers will bring food to your car.](#)

Northwest Community Action Partnership- Extra Helpings Food Pantry- Emergency food, must be income eligible, but income guidelines have been increased during COVID. Food can be picked up twice a month during COVID and more frequent pickup is available if needed. Extra Helping Food Pantry Hours: Tuesday 10:30 AM-12:00 PM and 1:00 PM-4:00 PM, Wednesday 10:30 AM-12:00 PM Friday 10:30-12:00 PM and 1:00 PM-4:00 PM. [The building is closed to the public. Go to the pantry at 127 West Second Street in Chadron during the above hours, stay in your car and call 747-2200 \(if no phone, honk your horn\) and groceries will be brought out.](#)

Shepherd's Pantry- Groceries provided by Immanuel Lutheran Church, Chadron (308)-432-5408 Call to make an arrangement, all welcome.

Western Community Health Resources-Commodity Supplemental Food Program- Distributes commodity food to income eligible residents 60 years or older who are income eligible and apply. Food is distributed every other month (January, March, May, July, September, November). Call 308-432-8979 to sign up and confirm your eligibility and you will be provided the pickup date and location. Clinics are set up as drive up so you do not need to leave your car.

Women, Infants, & Children (WIC)- Free food and nutrition information for income eligible pregnant or postpartum women and children up to age 5. Located at 300 Shelton Street.
