- ◇ The Weatherization Assistance Program is a free energy efficiency program designed to decrease energy costs for low-income families, especially the elderly, persons with disabilities and people with children.
- ◇ Improper insulation of your home could cause extreme energy loss and increase your bills
- ◇ Weatherizing your home may help you save up to 30% on your energy consumption each year!
- ◇ Weatherization can reduce your annual energy costs by about \$218 per year.

## *What is Weatherization?*

The weatherization program is a free energy efficiency program designed to help income eligible families decrease costs and make their homes more energy efficient.

### **Measure can include:**

- ◇ Insulation of attics, sidewalls, floors and foundation perimeter
- ◇ Sealing of heating ducts
- ◇ Weather stripping
- ◇ Tune-p, repair or upgrades on heating systems and/or water heaters
- ◇ Carbon Monoxide testing and detector installation
- ◇ Improve indoor air quality
- ◇ Measures to reduce air leakage
- ◇ Installing low-flow shower heads
- ◇ Energy efficient light bulbs
- ◇ Consumer education



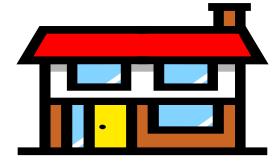
## *Who may qualify?*

- ◇ Households must meet specific program income guidelines;
- ◇ Homeowners of site build and mobile home homes
- ◇ Renters of site build or mobile homes may receive weatherization services with the property owner's approval;
- ◇ If your home has been weatherized by our program after September 1994 it cannot be weatherized again.
- ◇ Priorities are given to elderly, handicapped, and families with children under 6.

## *What happens next?*

- ◇ After the application is received and certified, your name will be added to the Weatherization waiting list.
- ◇ Certification of income is good for 365 days, after that you have to recertified.
- ◇ Once your application is selected, an energy auditor will call you to make an appointment for an energy audit. At the time of the audit, we will do a full assessment of the energy efficiency of your home and determine the eligible measures.
- ◇ Our fully trained crews will come into your house to make energy saving improvements and repairs.
- ◇ The work will make your home safe, comfortable, and energy efficient.
- ◇ Once completed, the Quality Control Inspector will return to your home to inspect the work that has been done to ensure it meets standards.
